General Directions

This mystery is a perfect opportunity to learn and practice some techniques. I have incorporated two techniques into some of the blocks for this quilt one being set in squares and the other being mitered corners. While designing the quilt and then making prototypes of the blocks I took the time to take step by step pictures to help visualize what I wrote for instructions. Anyone interested in learning or practicing these techniques will benefit tremendously from this particular mystery. The design is fabulous and looks quite intricate when pieced together but don't be alarmed because our little secret is all the blocks used are quite simple and easy to master with a little practice. No flying geese in this one either! The finished quilt size is 84" square.

I will be rolling out this mystery on Saturday the 25th of June. Sign-ups are \$8.00 now until the mystery begins on the 25th (click the link for registration). Once the 25th of June rolls around registration will go up to \$10.00 and then will increase once more to \$12.00 three weeks after the mystery starts. I encourage you to take advantage of the savings that early registration allows. There are six parts to this mystery and each part will be released every Saturday. Fabric auditions are encouraged by taking a picture of your fabric and posting it on the yahoo group site. I will set up some folders for the new mystery for you. I am really excited about this mystery and am confident you will love, love, love this design. I will be available to answer any questions you have before and during this mystery so don't be intimidated because it's all good.

Fabric Requirements

I only specify one color and that is for the background. On this one it is black. You will need two bright light fabrics, one bright medium fabric, and one medium fabric. Stay away from large prints. Tone on tone, marbles or bali fabrics will work very well with this one. I will tell you what colors I selected in the fabric requirements which will also be listed on the fabric key in all the directions.

Fabric A	3 ½ yards	medium	Harvest Gold
Fabric B	¾ yard	bright medium	Electric Blue
Fabric C	7/8 yard	bright light	Turquoise
Fabric D	½ yard	bright light	Pink
Background	4 ½ yards	dark	Black
